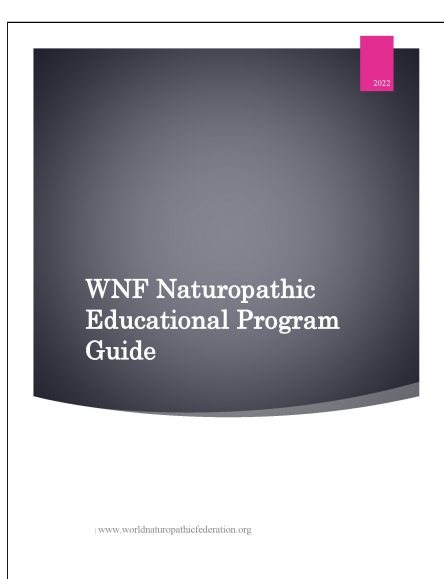

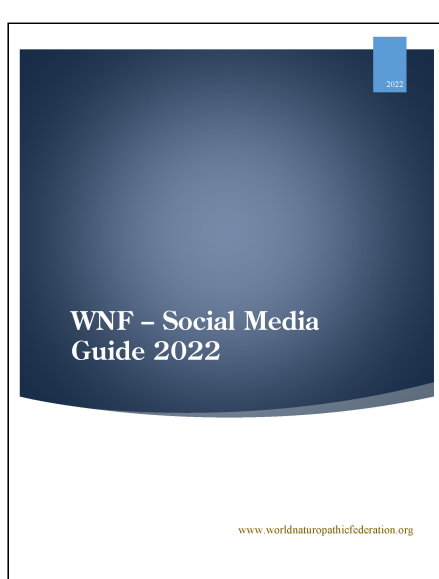


WNF Naturopathic Educational Program Guide

WNF Social Media Guide

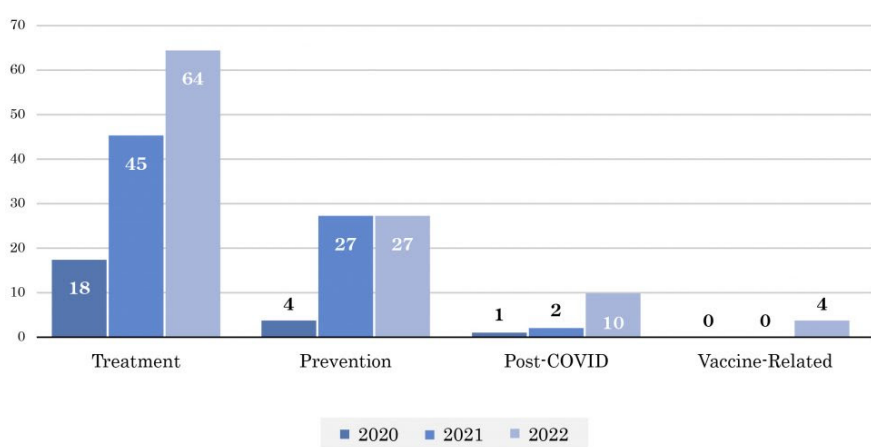

Live Review on Natural Health Products Researched with respect to the COVID Pandemic

The WNF and the [Canadian College of Naturopathic Medicine \(CCNM\)](#) have been updating the [Live Review on Natural Health Products \(NHPs\) Researched with respect to the COVID Pandemic](#) since May of 2022. The Live Review currently highlights over 200 systematic reviews related to NHPs used in the prevention and/or treatment of COVID. The Live Review ensures that the naturopathic profession is part of the conversation on COVID and that it is seen as a valuable resource in the greater healthcare discussion. We encourage you to share the monthly updates with your members and community.

TCIH Declaration Reminder

The WNF is one of the sponsoring organizations for the [Traditional, Complementary and Integrative Healthcare \(TCIH\) Declaration](#). The aim of the Declaration is to encourage governments to include TCIH in their healthcare system. We ask WNF members to sign the TCIH Declaration and to encourage their members to sign as individuals. The naturopathic profession continues to be leaders in TCIH.

HTA Launch

In December of 2021, the WNF published the [Health Technology Assessment \(HTA\) on Naturopathy](#). Since the time, copies of the HTA have been sent to WNF members and sponsors. The official launch of the HTA will be held in Australia on November 23rd hosted by our full member [Naturopaths and Herbalist Association of Australia \(NHAA\)](#). It is due to the financial support of NHAA that the WNF was able to complete the HTA. Details of the official launch will be posted on the WNF Social Media.

WNF General Assembly 2023

For the first time since 2019, the WNF will be holding an in-person General Assembly (GA) in 2023 (with a virtual option for aspects of the GA). The GA will be held in Switzerland. The date and agenda will be announced in the coming weeks. The focus of the GA will include detailed discussions on naturopathic educational standards and naturopathic research.
